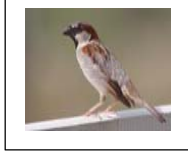

Topic



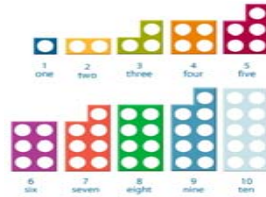
Our topic this term is **Kenya**.

REMINDERS

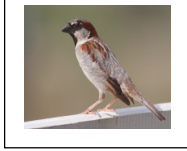

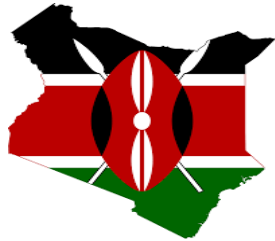

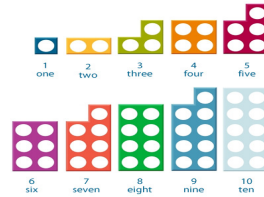
