Milk – Summer Term

Dear Parent / Carer,

As part of the new School Food Standards, schools are required to ensure milk is available during the school day to pupils who want it. Milk remains free for children until the term after their fifth birthday (Therefore if your child is in Reception and turns 5 after Thurs 29th March you will not have to pay this term) and those who would be entitled to Free School Meals (FSM). FSM are available to some children according to family income and should not be confused with Universal Free School Meals that are available to all Reception and Key Stage 1 pupils.

For children that do not qualify for free milk or FSM the cost for this term is £7.00. This will provide a daily drink of milk from **Monday 16th April – Tuesday 24th July**. Please complete the online link below and return to the school office any payment as soon as possible but **no later than Friday 23rd March. If you miss the cut-off date your child will be unable to have milk for the rest of the term. This date is put in place due to our deadlines with the dairy.**

Please give consent via website using the words 'Milk Summer'. Milk is ordered in advance and cannot be provided without payment or the completed form online. Unfortunately, no refunds can be given if you decide to discontinue with milk during the term.
