Topic



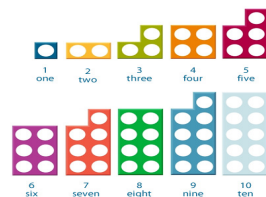
Our topic this term is **Kenya**.

This is a **Geography, Art and Computing** based topic.

In **Geography** we will be learning about the location, landscape and people of Kenya.

In **Art**, we will be linking our learning with **Geography** by creating collages of Kenyan landscapes. We will also be creating jewellery inspired by that worn by the Masai people of Kenya.

In **Computing**, we will create PowerPoint presentations showing our learning about **Kenya**.



Maths

In **Maths** we will be revising all the objectives taught throughout the previous terms. We will be developing fluency and reasoning involving all four operations. We will also be consolidating our understanding of measures including time, money and length.

English

This term we will be link **English** with **Geography** to write non-chronological reports about **Kenya**. We will concentrate on extending our sentences using conjunctions and use adjectives to make our writing as interesting as possible. Spelling is vitally important so we practise words of the week each day and encourage the completion of spelling homework. Thank you to all parents and carers for your support with this.
