


THE SHIPWRECK CHALLENGE

Engineering is all about being curious, solving problems and making things. Cruise into your Holiday Makers voyage with this kick-starter challenge.

YOUR CHALLENGE

You'll need:

- Kitchen foil
- Ice lolly sticks
- Pennies (treasure)
- Container with water (or even a paddling pool)



Your challenge is to build the ultimate tinfoil boat. Try different designs and see how much treasure you can load without becoming shipwrecked!

1

Make – Build your boat by bending the foil. What different shapes do ships have?

2

Predict – How many pennies can your boat carry before sinking?

3

Test – Put your boat into the water and count how many pennies it can hold before it sinks

4

Try again – How could you improve your design? Can you use lolly sticks creatively in your design to carry more treasure?
