Personal, Social & Emotional Development

We will be learning about similarities and differences in each other's families. We will be learning to cooperate with other children and join in group activities through turn taking and sharing. We will build our confidence and self-esteem through our experiences at school and become more independent learners. During circle time, we shall begin to talk about our emotions and feelings and work together as a team to build positive relationships with new adults and peers.

You can help by: Speaking to your child about their day at school and encouraging them to explain how they are feeling.

Communication & Language

We will be listening to each other in small groups and retelling special family occasions. We will build our vocabulary through stories, play and circle time.

Moving & Handling

We will be focusing on gross motor skills including climbing, balancing, hopping, skipping and negotiating across and around obstacles.

English

We will share stories to foster a love of reading and begin to learn Phase 2 Phonics. We will mark make using a variety of resources and begin to learn to form letters correctly.



Maths

We will be using number in play, matching numerals and quantities correctly. We will focus on one number each week to create an in depth understanding. **You can help by:** Noticing numbers in the environment e.g. house numbers, flat numbers.



The World

This half term we will be gardening. This will involve harvesting fruit, planting seeds and creating compost. We will learn about the life cycle of a plant and what they need to grow.

Expressive Arts

We will be drawing pictures of ourselves and our families using paint, chalk, oil pastels and other resources. We will be exploring instruments and the sounds that they make. We will be singing nursery rhymes and creating repeated rhythms using instruments and technology.
