This term we will be linking our English work with our topic

The Great Fire of London

to write an informative report about the fire and its impact. We will continue our work on developing story writing when we retell the story of The Three Little Pigs. In Phonics, we will be investigating spelling patterns of the sounds taught so far and applying them in our writing. The children have made amazing progress with cursive handwriting and we hope to develop this further.

We will post links to websites and activities we will be using to develop the children's understanding of The Great Fire of London.

In Maths this term we will be developing our understanding of multiplication, division and fractions. We will be looking at finding halves and quarters of shapes, numbers and amounts.

We will also be developing our understanding of numbers by sequencing, ordering and comparing them using our knowledge of place value.

Our topic for this half term is
'Animals, including humans'.

We will be learning about the importance of hygiene, including hand washing and how to prevent germs spreading. Children will also learn about making healthy food choices and why they are important.

In computing we are learning to code and debug basic programmes and algorithms.

Our theme for this term is 'How and why do people pray?' The children will learn about why prayer is important in a range of religions.
