I am pleased to announce that on Thursday 17th January 2019, year 6 will be going to Eden Camp for an exciting and interactive tour around the museum, to experience what life was like during World War I and II. This has great links to our History, Geography and Citizenship curriculum.

At Eden Camp, immersive displays bring history to life, allowing pupils and adults alike to experience the sights, sounds and smells of life on the Home Front and the Front Line, which encompasses a whole host of subjects and themes, from art, religious education and citizenship, to geography, design and science. Housed in unique settings, in the buildings and grounds of an original WWII Prisoner of War Camp, the museum offers a broad insight into all aspects of the social and military history of WWII, as well as WWI and post WWII conflicts. There will also be an opportunity to view a puppet show!

We have kindly subsidised the cost of this trip to only **£9.00 per child**. This will include the ticket price and return coach transport. If you need to speak to us about payment, please contact the school.
