Dear Parents/Carers,

It has been a pleasure to welcome the children back following the Easter break, it is hard to believe we are now in the Summer Term!

We have been working on a number of areas since the beginning of term and are delighted to share with you some of our plans and successes.

As always, we have an exciting STEM week planned for which will be taking place week commencing 17th June and have managed to secure a planetarium for the children to experience. Further details will follow from the STEM Team nearer the time.

We are delighted to announce we have successfully gained funding for The National School Breakfast Programme meaning we will once again be able to offer Bagels to all children; the scheme starts week commencing 6th May until July 2025. We will also be continuing Re-think Food until July 2025 giving access to a range of foods and supporting the school in it's bid to be as sustainable as possible.

The plans for Iveson Kitchen continue to grow and will form part of the schools ongoing development over the next few years as we develop a rigorous Outdoor Learning Curriculum and utilise this resource for the benefit of the school and community. The Bus is now open Friday morning and afternoon with the option to sit inside. The next stage of the development is to create outdoor seating followed by fencing.

Please can I remind all parents/carers that we have planned Sports Days to take place earlier this year with Y5&6 immediately after half term on Monday 3rd June, Y3&4 Tuesday 4th June, Y1&2 Thursday 6th June and EYFS on Friday 7th June. This is to balance the number and range of events that take place over the summer term but also allow us enough time and flexibility to re-schedule if rain means we have to postpone.

Please can I also remind parents to be considerate when parking access for emergency vehicles and those with the required permits is severely compromised when parents block driveways or unlawfully park on zig-zags and double yellow lines.

We are seeing an increase in the number of children bringing bikes and scooters to school and whilst we actively support this would request that they do not cycle or scooter in the school grounds to ensure the safety of all.
