

English

This half term we will be reading Shakespeare's 'Macbeth', exploring the plotlines, characters and dramatisation of the classic tale. We will then be using drama to inspire our own narratives.

In SPaG we will be consolidating the children's knowledge of grammar and spelling rules taught throughout the year in preparation for the upcoming SATs

For homework, children will also be asked to learn the statutory spellings for Year 5 and 6 alongside their weekly spelling rule.

Maths

This half term we will be focusing on properties of shape. The children will be exploring angles and known facts to delve deeper into problem solving linked to 2D and 3D shape.

The children will also be completing a revision session to consolidate learning ahead of SATs.

Educational Experience -



The children will take part in a real life debate about Greek society and will act as prevalent individuals from Ancient Greece.



We will also be completing an enterprise project linked to the Iveson kitchen, whereby we will grow our own pumpkins and explore real life entrepreneurial skills.



Science

Our topic will start with children investigating electricity and how it travels through a circuit. We will explore different components of circuitry and delve deeper into our understanding of 'The physics of Energy'.

From this the children will develop their understanding of how we see, using scientific diagrams and scientific vocabulary. We then will be creating adapted power sources and materials to demonstrate our learning.

In **Computing** children will be using excel to create their own spreadsheets. They will learn how to manage an event, evaluating cost, using various formula and calculations. In **DT** we are continuing with creating and designing our own burritos. The children will be exploring different seasonal vegetables and designing their own burritos. After, they will use a tortilla press and make their very own designs. In **RE** we will be studying religious art. We will be using our knowledge from all previous topics to look how beliefs are represented in art work. We will then be comparing the art. In **Art** we be studying Banksy and other famous street artists. We will exploring how art can be used to make statements about our world. We will then be creating our own street art.
